S.S.H.B.E.A. SPRING SHOW

The SSHBEA Spring Show will take place May 4-6, 2006 at the Calsonic Arena located in Shelbyville, Tennessee.

This year we have made a few changes to the class sheet and we hope that these are positive changes that will benefit all exhibitors.

We have **deleted** the following classes because of low participation based on the number of entries from the past spring shows. These classes will most likely be available at the fall show if enough interest is generated for the support of those classes.

1. Open Men's Amateur 4 Yrs. Old & Over, N/C
2. Lite Shod Men's Amateur 4 Yrs. Old & Over, N/C

In place of the above classes we have **added** the following:

1. Amateur Owned & Trained Country Trail Pleasure N/C (This is class #8 on the Spring 2006 class sheet.)
2. Model Horse Open - Amateur Handlers - 18 Years Old & Over (horse must be handled by an amateur only - horse cannot show in any other model class at this show, those classes are: 1, 2, 20, and 21). (This is class #36 on the Spring 2006 class sheet.)

In the **Lead Line** class all participants will receive a Blue Ribbon and Trophy. Please read the enclosed material on the deciding factors for this change.

The SSHBEA received a request to add a weanling class. but due to past experience with having this class at a Spring Show, there just was not enough interest or participation.

Sweepstakes

If your 2 year old was entered in the Sweepstakes at the 2005 Fall Show as a yearling, you are qualified to show in Two Year Old Sweepstakes at the 2006 Spring Show.

If you would like to enter a Two Year Old in the Spring Show Sweepstakes Classes "**that was not entered**" as a yearling the cost is \$100 nomination fee plus the entry fee. The \$100 nomination fee allows you to show in all sweepstakes classes through the 2006 season by just paying the additional entry fee at each show.

You may enter at the Spring show. We will not be taking advanced entries prior to the show.

The SSHBEA Rule Book will be enforced. **Applications to nominate for Breeders' Cup Sweepstakes will be available at SSHBEA Office and are available online by clicking www.sshbea.org.** All SSHBEA Rules will apply in all classes.

N/C - indicates NO CANTER

Canter - indicates WILL CANTER

ALL HORSES MUST BE SSHBEA REGISTERED TO SHOW

Trainers must have current "PSSHTA" trainer card. Amateurs must have current SSHBEA Amateur Card.

Youth may show in all classes except those designed mens and ladies. Men's and Ladies Classes are 18 Years & Over.

Youth 17 Years & Under Do Not Have To Purchase An Amateur Card. Youth & Amateur Owned & Trained **MUST NOT HAVE BEEN** Professionally Trained Within The Last 90 Days. 17 & Under - **NO STALLIONS** Permitted.

AMATEUR OWNED & TRAINED CLASS: Is one in which every contestant is either an amateur who owns the entry being shown, or is an Amateur Member of owner's immediate family.

Country Trail Pleasure Classes may not show in regular Trail Pleasure classes and Trail Pleasure entries may not show in Country Trail Pleasure classes. Head shake not allowed at any given show.

Leadline – Previous rules apply, all participants will receive a blue ribbon and trophy.

ENTRY FEES: All classes (except #40, #41 & #61) \$15

PRIZE MONEY: \$40, \$30, \$20, \$15, \$10, R, R, R

CLASS 40 - No Entry Fee (Ribbons to all Entries)

CLASS 41 - Entry Fee \$5 Blue Ribbon and Trophy to all entries

CLASS 61 - Entry Fee \$25

PRIZE MONEY: \$100, \$75, \$50, \$40, \$30, R, R, R

Trail Pleasure (Keg Shod) - Shoe may not exceed 3/4" wide & 3/8" thick. Caulk can be 1", measured from the back of the shoe.

Open Shod Shoe - Must not exceed 1 1/2" wide by 1/2" thick with the exception of caulk which must be no thicker than 1" and the turnback which shall not exceed 1".

Lite Shod Shoe - May not exceed 1" wide x 3/8" thick with the exception of caulk which must be no thicker than 3/4" and the turnback which shall not exceed 3/4".

Country Trail Pleasure - Manufactured cast keg shoe, not to exceed 3/8" x 3/4" and toe must not exceed 4 inches.



IMPORTANT SSHBEA TOBIANO RULING

Registration Qualifications – Effective January 1, 2007



Rule #3.25

Effective January 1, 2007 a horse must satisfy all existing qualifications for registration and must additionally be a product of either a SSHBEA registered Tobiano sire or SSHBEA registered Tobiano dam. Tobiano is defined to be a horse that has the appearance or phenotype which is indicative of a horse that has the Tobiano gene.

Important Information

Breedings in 2006 should be planned to enable foals in 2007 to be registered in accordance with the rule. Horses that do not satisfy the requirement of the rule must be registered prior to 2007.

This rule was mailed to the current SSHBEA membership with voting privileges as of June 21, 2005 per directions of the SSHBEA Board of Directors. The ballots were mailed First Class from the Shelbyville, TN US Post Office on July 15, 2005 to 2,507 SSHBEA Members.

Rule #3.25 was approved by a majority of the returned ballots.

The Credentials Committee and Executive Secretary have not indicated any irregularities in voting or mailings of ballots. (This statement is in response to any who questioned the results and has stated that they did not receive a ballot). If anyone has questions about Rule #3.25 please contact the SSHBEA Office. The Board of Directors is committed to accurately informing our Membership.

SSHBEA RULE CHANGES, ADDITIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

19 - Rules for the Trail Pleasure Division

Rule 19.9 Currently reads: The horse should perform on a relaxed rein, and be ridden with one hand. However Youth Exhibitors 11 years of age and under may use two hands.

Change to read: The horse should perform on a relaxed rein and be ridden with one hand, and the rider may switch hands on the reverse. Youth Exhibitors 11 years of age and under may use two hands.

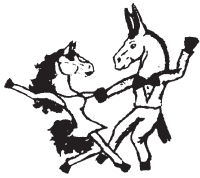
24 - Rules for the conduct of Judges

Rule 24.13 Currently reads: A Judge suspended by the SSHBEA may judge a show that he/she had contracted to Judge prior to suspension. However it is the responsibility of that suspended Judge to obtain from the Show Committee a copy of his/her contract and submit it to SSHBEA.

Change to read: A Judge suspended by the SSHBEA may not judge any horse show.

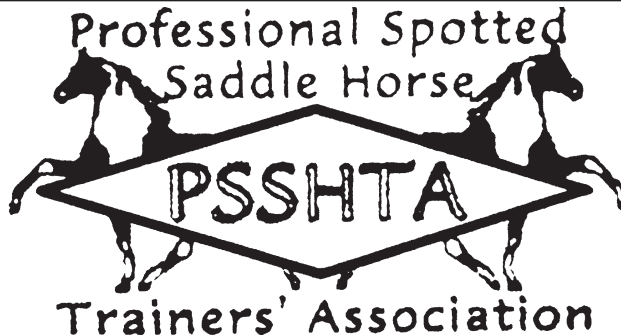

All SSHBEA SPORT HORSE Rules apply in all events (This includes full western dress& proper grooming of horse-Rules 39.1-#1-For all competition, all contestants must use clean Western tack in good working condition. Horn on Western Saddle is optional. #2-Grooming, neatness and cleanliness of horse will be necessary). Classes are for Spotted Saddle Horses only-Horses must exhibit saddle gait. All horses must be SSHBEA registered and registration # is required for entries. In all classes (excluding fun classes) a 5 second penalty in timed divisions and disqualification in untimed divisions will be assessed if the hat or helmet is not on the contestant's person the entire time the contestant is in the arena. (Hats held on the body by stampede strings are allowed.) For anything not covered by Sport Horse Rules-refer to SSHBEA Official Rules. Rulebooks may be obtained from SSHBEA Office.

Non Pro classes will not count points for the SSHBEA High Point Division

NOTE: In Non Pro classes, once you have received 15 blue ribbons you are no longer eligible to show Non Pro

ATTENTION:

No practicing or training in Deck area for safety purposes

ALL 11 & UNDER ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR HELMETS

Helmets are encouraged for all ages and events

ALL 6 & UNDER ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE FEET IN STIRRUPS

Buddy stirrups are acceptable

SSHBEA REGISTRATION NUMBERS ARE REQUIRED FOR ENTRIES
